

## Be a Good Neighbor, Feed a Gator Meal Card Distribution Protocol

### Program Summary

*Be a Good Neighbor, Feed a Gator* is a program of San Francisco State University's Basic Needs Initiative. This program responds to campus food insecurity and hunger by providing free meal cards to students. Students can be screened for card eligibility at the Dean on Call program, CalFresh Help Clinic or Student Health Services Nutrition Clinic. Meal cards can be used at the City Eats dining hall on campus.

### Service Delivery 2018/19

During the 2018/19 academic year, *Be a Good Neighbor, Feed a Gator* provided a total of 202 hot meals from City Eats to a 26 eligible students.
